Membership dues alone do not cover costs for the Club activities. Money is needed to cover membership costs, family room support, watch parties/receptions, luncheons, advertising, website, concession coupons, donations to SASS, Hockey Program, etc.

We have many volunteer activities that help the Club raise additional money. The Board of Directors is asking you to review the information below and maybe volunteer for some of these activities:

- Our biggest fund raiser is selling 50/50 tickets at kiosks at select sporting events. The Club receives a nominal fee for each volunteer. At Football games we arrive 2 hours before kickoff to sell pre-game through half time - includes bus pass from Farm Lane parking to and from the stadium and a food voucher – volunteers are welcome to stay and watch the remainder of the game. Basketball is 2 hours before the game through half-time and again volunteers are welcome to stay and watch the remainder of the game. Hockey is approximately 2 hours before the game through the 2<sup>nd</sup> period (we split the time up so we would like 4 volunteers).
- We have a Membership and Merchandise Table at home games where we sell Club merchandise and Club membership packets – we need people to work at the table at each game. 1 ½ hour before the game to the end of the 1<sup>st</sup> period. (2 – 3 volunteers)
- We also have been asked to Host the “Family Room” where players parents, families and alumni can get together prior to the game, during intermissions and following the game for a short time. (1 board member and 2 volunteers)
