Volunteer Information:

Membership dues alone do not cover costs for the Club activities. Money is needed to cover membership costs, family room support, watch parties/receptions, luncheons, advertising, website, donations to SASS, Hockey Program, etc.

We have many volunteer activities that help the Club raise additional money. The Board of Directors is asking you to review the information below and maybe volunteer for some of these activities:

- Our biggest fund raiser is selling 50/50 tickets at kiosks at select sporting events. The Club receives a nominal fee for each volunteer. At Football games we arrive 2 hours before kickoff to sell pre-game through half time includes bus pass from Farm Lane parking to and from the stadium and a food voucher volunteers are welcome to stay and watch the remainder of the game. Basketball is 2 hours before the game through half-time and again volunteers are welcome to stay and watch the remainder of the game. Hockey is approximately 1 1/2 hours before the game through the 2nd period (we split the time up so we would like 4 volunteers).
- We also have been asked to Host the "Family Room" where players parents, families and alumni can get together prior to the game, during intermissions and following the game for a short time. (1 board member and 2-3 Club Members
- You must be 18 or older to volunteer and are required to complete a background check through the University. We will be sure you have the link to complete the form on-line. Background checks are required prior to entering through Security, at assigned venue, before doors open.
